TWENTY-SEVEN (27) IDENTIFIED UNLAWFUL TACTICS COMMONLY USED BY CORRUPTED CHILD-PROTECTION, JUDICIAL, AND ADMINISTRATIVE SYSTEMS, WITH THE CORRESPONDING LAWS AND LEGAL VIOLATIONS CITABLE FOR LAWFUL SELF-DEFENSE

PURPOSE AND LAWFUL INTENT:

THIS DOCUMENT IS ISSUED FOR EDUCATIONAL, PREVENTATIVE, AND LAWFUL SELF-DEFENSE PURPOSES. IT IDENTIFIES AND MAPS TWENTY-SEVEN (27) COMMON UNLAWFUL TACTICS UTILIZED BY CORRUPTED CHILD-PROTECTION, JUDICIAL, AND ADMINISTRATIVE SYSTEMS, AND CORRELATES EACH TACTIC WITH THE APPLICABLE STATUTORY, CONSTITUTIONAL, AND HUMAN-RIGHTS LAWS THAT ARE BREACHED BY SUCH CONDUCT. THE SOLE PURPOSE OF THIS FRAMEWORK IS TO EMPOWER PARENTS, GUARDIANS, AND LAWFUL CAREGIVERS WITH KNOWLEDGE OF THEIR RIGHTS, TO PREVENT UNLAWFUL INTERFERENCE, TO ENABLE INFORMED AND PEACEFUL LAWFUL SELF-DEFENSE, AND TO PROMOTE COMPLIANCE WITH THE UNIVERSAL PRINCIPLES OF DUE PROCESS, DO NO HARM, AND THE BEST INTERESTS AND INTRINSIC RIGHTS OF THE CHILD.

THIS FRAMEWORK APPLIES TO ALL CHILD-PROTECTION, JUDICIAL, AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS WHERE UNALIENABLE RIGHTS, DUE PROCESS, AND THE DO-NO-HARM PRINCIPLE ARE IMPLICATED.

EACH OF THE FOLLOWING TWENTY-SEVEN (27) TACTICS IS PRESENTED WITH ITS CORRESPONDING LEGAL BREACHES TO ENABLE DIRECT, LAWFUL SELF-DEFENSE AND IMMEDIATE IDENTIFICATION OF RIGHTS VIOLATIONS.

This framework is based on universally recognized human rights, including the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and binding United Nations human-rights treaties, and can be used worldwide.

Where European or Austrian laws are cited, they apply directly and legally in Europe and Austria. Outside Europe, these references should be understood in the same spirit and replaced with the corresponding human-rights and constitutional protections that apply in the user's own country or legal system.

1. Predetermined Outcome

Tactic:

A decision is effectively made before evidence is heard or assessed.

Right Violated:

Right to a fair and impartial process.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6, European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR) – right to a fair hearing
- Article 83(2), Austrian Federal Constitution (B-VG) – prohibition of arbitrary courts
- Article 18, Austrian Federal Constitution (B-VG) – administration bound by law, not discretion

2. Ignoring or Suppressing Exculpatory Evidence

Tactic:

Evidence, objections, or facts that contradict the chosen narrative are ignored or excluded without lawful reasoning.

Right Violated:

Right to be heard; right to defense.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to a fair trial / fair hearing – equality of arms
- § 37 AVG (General Administrative Procedure Act) – duty to establish the material truth
- Article 47, EU Charter of Fundamental Rights – right to an effective remedy and fair procedure

3. Acting on Assumption Rather Than Proof

Tactic:

Authorities proceed on unproven allegations or assumptions rather than verified facts.

Right Violated:

Presumption of innocence; legality of State action.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 18 B-VG – no State action without legal basis
- § 45 AVG – evidence must be suitable and sufficient

4. Disproportionate Removal of Children

Tactic:

Children are removed or retained without imminent danger, necessity, or proportionality.

Right Violated:

Right to family life; best interests of the Child.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 8 ECHR – right to family life
- Articles 3 & 9, UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC)
- § 176 ABGB – State intervention only if child welfare is endangered

5. Selective Enforcement / Institutional Bias

Tactic:

One party's breaches are ignored while the other party is sanctioned or burdened.

Right Violated:

Equality before the law; impartiality.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 7 B-VG – equality principle
- Article 14 ECHR – prohibition of discrimination
- § 302 StGB (Criminal Code) – abuse of authority (where officials knowingly misuse power)

6. Failure to Enforce Existing Court Orders

Tactic:

Authorities fail or refuse to enforce valid court orders, or selectively ignore breaches.

Right Violated:

Right to legal certainty; right to an effective remedy.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 13 ECHR – right to an effective remedy
- Article 18 B-VG – administration bound by law
- ECtHR jurisprudence – failure to enforce judgments constitutes a violation of Article 6

7. Retaliation for Asserting Rights or Filing Complaints

Tactic:

A parent is penalized, targeted, or disadvantaged after filing objections, complaints, or asserting lawful rights.

Right Violated:

Access to justice; freedom from retaliation.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 13 ECHR – effective remedy
- Article 6 ECHR – fair procedure
- § 302 StGB – abuse of authority (where officials knowingly misuse power)

8. Withholding or Delaying Information

Tactic:

Authorities delay, obstruct, or refuse access to files, reasons for decisions, or procedural information.

Right Violated:

Right to be informed; right to defense.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to a fair trial / fair hearing - equality of arms
- § 17 AVG – right to inspect files
- § 58 AVG – duty to give reasons for decisions

9. Shifting or Undefined Allegations

Tactic:

Allegations change over time, remain vague, or are never clearly specified.

Right Violated:

Right to legal certainty; right to defense.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to know the case against oneself
- Article 18 B-VG – legality principle
- § 37 AVG – duty to clarify facts fully and consistently

10. Procedural Delay as a Tactic

Tactic:

Delays are used to exhaust, pressure, or disadvantage a parent rather than to serve justice.

Right Violated:

Right to timely justice.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6(1) ECHR – right to a hearing within a reasonable time
- Article 13 ECHR – effective remedy
- § 73 AVG – duty to decide without unnecessary delay

11. Reliance on Unqualified or Biased “Expert” Opinions

Tactic:

Authorities rely on psychological, social, or expert assessments that are unqualified, biased, speculative, or not independently verified.

Right Violated:

Right to fair procedure; right to reliable evidence.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to a fair trial / fair hearing - equality of arms
- § 45 AVG – evidence must be suitable and reliable
- § 52 AVG – expert opinions must meet objectivity and competence requirements
- Article 18 B-VG – administration bound by law, not arbitrary opinion

12. Treating Administrative Allegations as Established Facts

Tactic:

Unproven administrative claims are treated as facts without judicial determination.

Right Violated:

Presumption of innocence; legality of State action.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6(2) ECHR – presumption of innocence
- Article 18 B-VG – legality principle
- § 37 AVG – obligation to establish facts before deciding

13. Failure to Hear the Parent Properly

Tactic:

The parent is not genuinely heard, is interrupted, marginalized, or excluded from meaningful participation.

Right Violated:

Right to be heard; procedural fairness.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to be heard
- § 41 AVG – right of parties to participate in proceedings
- Article 83 B-VG – lawful adjudication

14. Substituting Administrative Convenience for Child's Best Interests

Tactic:

Decisions are made for institutional ease rather than the actual best interests of the Child.

Right Violated:

Best interests of the Child; right to family life.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 3 CRC – best interests of the Child as a primary consideration
- Article 8 ECHR – family life
- § 138 ABGB – parental responsibility and welfare standard

15. Using "Risk" Language Without Concrete Evidence

Tactic:

Vague or speculative “risk” claims are used to justify severe measures without substantiation.

Right Violated:

Right to proportionality; legality of interference.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 8 ECHR – proportionality requirement
- § 176 ABGB – intervention only with real endangerment
- Article 18 B-VG – no action without lawful basis

16. Coercion Through Threats of Escalation or Punishment

Tactic:

Authorities threaten harsher measures, loss of access, or further sanctions to force compliance rather than resolve lawfully.

Right Violated:

Freedom from coercion; right to voluntary consent.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – fair procedure free from undue pressure
- Article 8 ECHR – interference must be lawful and necessary
- § 302 StGB – abuse of authority (coercive misuse of official power)

17. Conditioning Parental Rights on Compliance

Tactic:

Access to Children or parental rights are made conditional on compliance with unlawful demands or acceptance of unproven allegations.

Right Violated:

Right to family life; prohibition of arbitrary conditions.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 8 ECHR – right to family life
- Articles 3 & 9 CRC – child–parent relationship protected
- § 176 ABGB – intervention only for actual endangerment

18. Silencing Through Procedural Complexity or Intimidation

Tactic:

Parents are overwhelmed with complex procedures, deadlines, or legal language to deter participation or defense.

Right Violated:

Access to justice; effective participation.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – effective access to court
- Article 13 ECHR – effective remedy
- § 37 AVG – duty to clarify facts, not obstruct parties

19. Ignoring or Undermining Lawful Representatives or Support Persons

Tactic:

Authorities dismiss or marginalize lawful representatives, support persons, or witnesses without justification.

Right Violated:

Right to defense; Right to a fair trial / fair hearing - equality of arms.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to a fair trial / fair hearing - equality of arms
- § 10 AVG – right to representation
- Article 18 B-VG – legality principle

20. Acting Outside Jurisdiction or Mandate

Tactic:

Authorities take actions beyond their legal competence or mandate.

Right Violated:

Protection from unlawful State action.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 18 B-VG – administration bound strictly by law
- Article 83 B-VG – lawful jurisdiction

- § 302 StGB – abuse of authority (where competence is knowingly exceeded)

21. Manipulation or Selective Recording of Files

Tactic:

Records are selectively written, altered, summarized inaccurately, or omissions are made to support a predetermined narrative.

Right Violated:

Right to truthful procedure; right to defense.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – fair procedure
- § 37 AVG – duty to establish the material truth
- § 302 StGB – Abuse of authority (where public officials manipulate files or falsify records)
- § 295 StGB – Suppression of evidence (where evidence is suppressed, removed, destroyed, concealed, or withheld)
- § 289 StGB – False testimony / false expert opinion (only where witnesses or experts knowingly provide false statements or opinions)

22. Reliance on Internal Reports While Excluding External Evidence

Tactic:

Authorities rely solely on internal reports while dismissing independent or external evidence.

Right Violated:

Right to a fair trial / fair hearing - equality of arms; impartial assessment of evidence.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6 ECHR – right to a fair trial / fair hearing - equality of arms
- § 45 AVG – suitability and completeness of evidence
- Article 18 B-VG – legality principle

23. Reputational Framing of the Parent

Tactic:

A parent is portrayed negatively through insinuation, labeling, or unsupported character judgments.

Right Violated:

Human dignity; presumption of innocence.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6(2) ECHR – presumption of innocence
- Article 8 ECHR – protection of reputation as part of private life
- § 111 StGB – defamation (where false statements harm reputation)

24. Institutional Self-Protection Over Correction

Tactic:

Authorities prioritize protecting the institution or officials rather than correcting unlawful actions.

Right Violated:

Right to effective remedy; accountability.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 13 ECHR – effective remedy
- Article 18 B-VG – administration bound by law
- § 302 StGB – abuse of authority (failure to act where duty exists)

25. Refusal to Conclude or Remedy the Matter

Tactic:

Cases are kept open indefinitely, remedies are delayed, or resolution is avoided despite clarity.

Right Violated:

Right to legal certainty; right to timely justice.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 6(1) ECHR – reasonable time requirement
- Article 13 ECHR – right to an effective remedy
- § 73 AVG – obligation to decide without unnecessary delay
- Article 18 B-VG – legality and duty to act

26. Coercion into Psychological Evaluation Without Lawful Basis or Valid Consent

Tactic:

Psychological or psychiatric evaluations are imposed or pressured without valid informed consent, or conducted without personal examination, sufficient data, or methodological foundation, using biased or speculative assessments to pathologize lawful dissent, refusal, or belief.

Right Violated:

Right to private life and mental integrity; right to self-determination; freedom of thought and conscience; right to a fair trial; freedom from coercion.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- Article 8 ECHR – right to respect for private life (including mental integrity)
- Article 6(1) ECHR – right to a fair trial / fair hearing (impartial evidence)
- Article 9 ECHR – freedom of thought, conscience, and belief
- Article 18 B-VG – no state action without lawful basis
- § 45 AVG – evidence must be suitable, necessary, and proportionate
- § 52 AVG – expert opinions require objectivity, competence, and sufficient factual basis
- §§ 9 and 13 Psychologengesetz 2013 (PsyG) – psychological examinations and diagnostic procedures require valid informed consent and a personal examination; diagnoses or psychodiagnostic judgments without consent, personal contact, or sufficient data are impermissible
- § 302 StGB – abuse of authority (where coercion or misuse of expert procedures occurs)

27. Denial and Criminalization of Lawful Self-Defense and Self-Determination

Tactic:

unlawfully interference with personal liberty, family life, or parental rights while delegitimizing or pathologizing a parent's lawful resistance, refusal, or assertion of fundamental rights in order to suppress self-determination and justify continued or escalated coercive measures.

Right Violated:

Right to personal liberty; right to family life; right to self-determination; freedom of conscience; right to lawful self-defense.

Law / Rights Contravened:

- § 3 StGB – Notwehr (right to defend against an unlawful attack on legally protected interests)
- Article 2 ECHR – right to life (recognition of lawful defense against unlawful violence)

- Article 9 ECHR – freedom of thought, conscience, and belief
- Article 13 ECHR – right to an effective remedy (rights must be practical and effective)
- Article 18 B-VG – no state action without legal basis
- § 176 ABGB – state intervention only in cases of actual endangerment
